

The Sanctuary Light

"The Lord said to Moses: Order the Israelites to bring you clear oil of crushed olives for the light, so that you may keep the lamp burning regularly. In the tent of meeting, outside the veil that hangs in front of the covenant, Aaron shall set up the lamp to burn before the Lord regularly, from evening till morning, by a perpetual statute throughout your generations. He shall set up the lamps on the pure gold menorah to burn regularly before the LORD." (Leviticus 24:2-4; Exodus 27:20-21)

Adult Faith Formation

Beginning Sunday, September 12, 9:30-10:45am Pre-registration is not required.

A parish team will lead the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA), which will meet downstairs in the Fr. Jeremiah Trecy Room at the administrative building next to the church. Anyone wanting to learn more about the Catholic Faith — whether to consider joining the Church or simply to enrich one's knowledge and faith is welcome. Contact the parish office if you have questions.

Mike Janssen will lead a faith-sharing study group with the focus on discussing relevant topics associated with our Catholic faith. Don't miss the first session as the group will actively participate in building a "mind map" centered around religious education. From this discussion, topics will be selected with sup-porting material taken from a variety of available sources. Been scratching your head or praying about a certain aspect of our faith? Come share your thoughts and ideas with your fellow parishioners and together we'll dive a little deeper into our faith and its practice. This group will meet upstairs in the administrative building direction signs to the meeting location will be posted.

Evelyn Jaap will lead a group that will meet in the gym at the parish center and will view and discuss the series At the Table with Jesus: Do This in Remembrance of Me presented on DVD by Franciscan priest Fr. William L. Burton, O.F.M. He explores the question, "Why did Jesus ask his disciples to remember him by partaking in a meal?" Fr. Burton discusses the historical context and development of the Last Supper, and he leads us to an understanding of communal meals as Jesus saw them: a way of sharing the Gospel. Sample topics are: "Jewish Notions of Food," "Table-Sharing in the Gospel of Luke," and "The Largesse of God." After each 25minute video, the group shares insights, questions, and stories of faith.
